### The JHG Texas Nursing Scholarship Program Investor Update May 9, 2018

Thanks to your generous support, the JHG Texas Nursing Scholarship Program has taken off!

In the last 12 months, we have granted \$25,000 in received investments, spread among five \$5,000 nursing scholarships, at two Dallas area nursing schools to help alleviate the nursing shortage in Texas. Our grants make available three scholarships at DCCCD Nursing Schools and two scholarships at the nationally ranked TWU College of Nursing (Dallas Campus).

#### Introducing the First JHG Texas Nursing Scholar

Sabia was selected from a group of 31 qualified applicants at the DCCCD Foundation in 2017, where 63% of students come from households earning less than 80% of median family income and the annual cost of attending nursing school exceeds \$10,000. The DCCCD school of nursing awards an average of 400 nursing Associates Degrees annually.

Miss Sabharwal commented, ***“JHG Texas Nursing Scholarships offer more than financial assistance. The Scholarship demonstrates that others believe in my abilities, which gives me ‘heart’ and added self-assurance to encourage me in pursuing my lifelong dream of becoming a nurse.”***



In 2018, JHG Texas also granted two nursing scholarships of \$5,000 each at the highly ranked TWU College of Nursing in Dallas, which offers a BS (and post graduate degrees). At TWU, 55.5% of nursing students are from low-income families. As such, more than half of the 700 nursing students at TWU need financial assistance to help cover the estimated \$10,800 annual cost of their tuition, fees and other expenses at the College of Nursing in Dallas.

Hospital staff tell us that there is a shortage of good, well-educated nurses in particular. The **JHG Texas Nursing Scholarship** supports higher achieving nursing students, as each of our \$5,000 investments in scholarships at TWU targets serious nursing students in their junior and senior years with an average 3.7 GPA. This target also ensures a higher graduation success rate.
