2021-2022 Update

The Myers-JHG Tutoring and Academic Support Center continues to support TWU's excellence in nursing education. Located on the 7th floor of the T. Boone Pickens Institute of Health Sciences at TWU Dallas and overseen by Associate Dean, Dr. Kristine Morris, and Assistant Clinical Professor and Tutoring Coordinator, Dr. Rachelle Campbell, state of the art instructional technology is available to promote the learning and development of nursing students. Services are offered to students, both virtually and in person. This past year, the Center joined the membership of the College Reading and Learning Association (CRLA), as well as became a model of excellence in student academic support for other nursing programs around the country. To date, 268.25 hours of 1:1 academic tutoring have benefited 106 undergraduate and graduate students across 69 course sections. Tutoring is free of charge to all student nurses at TWU and with nearly 50% of students Pell eligible, the Myers-JHG Tutoring and Academic Support Center continues to serve a tremendous benefit to those who are economically disadvantaged. Undergraduate and graduate students, including graduate nurse education students (future faculty educators), serve as tutors offering a two-fold benefit: 1) student participants excel through peer mentorship and 2) nurse educator students earn clinical practicum hours as tutors.

Student Outcomes:

- Tutee performance was assessed by reviewing overall grade point average (GPA) for each semester in all coursework (didactic and clinical) for those students receiving services.
 - Spring 2021: Overall GPA – 3.045 (UG)
 - Summer 2021: Overall GPA – 3.361 (UG); 3.0 (G)
 - Fall 2021: Overall GPA – 2.779 (UG); 3.75 (G)
 - Spring 2022: Overall GPA - 2.94 UG; N/A (G)
 - Summer 2022: N/A
- Tutoring session evaluations were assessed via survey following each session to date.
 - My tutor explained the subject matter so I could understand it.
 - 87.6% Strongly Agreed; 9.5% Agreed
 - My tutor suggested ways to improve my study habits.
 - 76.2% Strongly Agreed; 19% Agreed
- Student comments were also elicited regarding their experience following each session.

- o “Thank you so much!! I had a huge turnaround and was able to better understand concepts test questions this time. Also using the test taking strategies, I got my highest grade yet, an A!”
- o “She was really good! I like the way she applied the information I learned into real nursing situations! And how she explained things to me until I thoroughly understood it.”
- o “She is the best tutor I ever had. She explained [the] material to me very well. She made the learning environment easy and comfortable. I wasn't shy to ask her about anything that came up in my mind. Thanks to her.”
- o The tutor “is amazing! She explained everything very well and also gave me confidence in my own skills/knowledge base.”

Future Directions:

- College of Nursing faculty collaboration with course leads/managers. The faculty will be oriented to the services of the tutoring center. This allows faculty to not only recommend students that need tutoring but to recommend their stellar students that would fit the requirements of peer tutor.
- Group tutoring for nursing calculations (this is an area of high need). Improve grades and decrease attrition as a result of medical math.
- Assign specific peer tutors to the nursing courses to ensure faculty can communicate directly with the peer tutor that will work with their students.
- Increase use of the tutoring center by graduate level nursing students. The need for advanced practice nurses is on the rise as much as for registered nurses.
