**Prepared for the Johanniter Humanitarian Group of Texas**

Since 2019, JHG Texas has donated \$82,000 to the University of Texas at Arlington’s College of Nursing and Health Innovation to provide scholarships to nursing students who have high academic achievement and financial need. To date, 44 scholarships have been awarded. Of these, 27 have graduated and 17 are on-target to graduate in the coming year.
